Wizz Air Baggage Allowance

Wizz Air has a generous baggage policy:

- **Carry-on:** Economy class passengers may bring one piece of hand luggage and one personal item. Business and First Class passengers may bring additional carry-on items.
- **Checked baggage:** Allowance depends on your route, class, and fare type. Economy class usually allows 25–30 kg, while Business and First Class can take up to 40–50 kg per passenger.
- Special or oversized baggage is subject to fees.

Tip: Always confirm baggage allowance with your ticket class before traveling.
