How to Get Your Air France Boarding Pass

Online or Mobile Check-In +1-803-335-2310

- Starting about 30 hours before departure (or 24 hours for many US-departure flights) you can check in via the Air France website or mobile app +1-803-335-2310. Air France USA+2airlines-guide.com+2

- If you have only carry-on (no checked baggage), mobile or printed pass is usually enough — you can head straight to security and then to your gate +1-803-335-2310. TheflightExpress+1

If you prefer, or if online check-in doesn't work (or isn't allowed for your flight), Air France lets you get your boarding pass at the airport +1-803-335-2310.

- Use an interactive self-service kiosk (available at most airports) you enter your reservation or ticket information and get your boarding pass printed +1-803-335-2310. Cparici+2SeatMaestro+2
- Alternatively, go to the Air France check-in counter airline staff will print your boarding pass for you +1-803-335-2310.
