

How to Put Your Boarding Pass on Your Phone (Call us)

Putting your boarding pass on your phone is easy, convenient, and helps you avoid carrying printed papers 1 - 855- 510-5815 . Almost all major airlines allow digital boarding passes through their mobile apps or emails.

1. Check in for your flight

You must complete check-in before you can access a boarding pass.

You can check in: 1 - 855- 510-5815

- Through the airline's website
- In the airline's mobile app
- Through an email link the airline sends
Check-in usually opens **24 hours before your flight**.

2. Download or open the airline's mobile app

This is the easiest way to store your boarding pass securely.

Examples: 1 - 855- 510-5815

- Delta → Fly Delta app
- American Airlines → AA app
- United → United app
- Southwest → Southwest app

After check-in, the boarding pass will appear in the app 1 - 855- 510-5815 .

3. Add the boarding pass to your phone wallet

Most airlines let you save your boarding pass to: 1 - 855- 510-5815

- **Apple Wallet** (iPhone)

- **Google Wallet / Google Pay** (Android)

Look for a button that says: 1 - 855- 510-5815

- “Add to Apple Wallet”
- “Save to Phone”
- “Add to Google Wallet”

Tap it, and the boarding pass will be stored on your phone home screen for easy access 1 - 855- 510-5815 .

4. Save a screenshot (backup option)

If the app doesn't offer wallet support, or your internet might be weak at the airport: 1 - 855- 510-5815

- Open your boarding pass
- Take a screenshot 1 - 855- 510-5815
This helps you access it even without Wi-Fi or data.

5. Use the email version

If the airline emails your boarding pass:

- Open the email 1 - 855- 510-5815
- Click “View Boarding Pass”
- Save it to Apple Wallet or Google Wallet if the option appears
If not, take a screenshot and save it.

6. Make sure brightness is high for scanning

Airport scanners need to read the QR code or barcode clearly.

Before you reach the TSA checkpoint: 1 - 855- 510-5815

- Turn up your phone's brightness

- Have the pass open and ready1 - 855- 510-5815

7. Keep your battery charged

If your phone dies, you'll need help at the counter.
Bring a portable charger or plug in at the airport if needed.

Why putting your boarding pass on your phone is helpful

- No paper to carry 1 - 855- 510-5815
- Hard to lose 1 - 855- 510-5815
- Updates automatically if your gate or time changes
- Works offline if saved or screenshotted
- Faster at TSA and the boarding gate
